


In the First Week we will go over some basic drawing and designing the painting. Hints are given on good composition and drawing basics. Supplies such as brushes and canvases will be discussed in the first session. The paint, canvas, and brushes will be provided for the three classes, but the supplies must stay at the art center. Bring drawings or a photo that you want to paint. The instructor will demonstrate painting. Second Week: Getting the painting started, the drawing and idea, tips to transfer the student's drawing. Third Week: Completing the painting. Discussions in framing, signing the painting, and how to hang the painting will take place. The instructor will have a short demonstration each session and have examples of her work on hand. Each student will be encouraged to work at their own comfortable pace. If the student has their own supplies at home, they can take the painting home and work on it in between sessions. If a student finishes their painting, they will be able to start another. With parents' approval, students can contact the instructor during or following the end of the class, for advice on completing the painting or answering their questions, or want a critique via email. If the student has their own paint they prefer to use, they should bring it to class. For this class, I recommend Liquitex Acrylic but there are many fine acrylic paints out there. 


